

ARTICLE V-SECTION 1 - NOMINATIONS, ELECTIONS, ELIGIBILITY, 20 ABSENTEE BALLOTS, FISCAL YEAR

At the regular General Membership Meeting held in October of each year, there shall be nominated at least one candidate for each of the elected offices. To be eligible for the office of Commodore, a member must have served at least two terms in one or more elective offices. To be eligible for the office of Vice Commodore, a member must have served at least one term in an elective office. To be eligible for an elective office, a member must have maintained his membership in good standing for at least one year. For purposes of this section only, a term will consist of one full year of elected office.

ARTICLE VII - DUTIES OF OFFICERS AND COMMITTEES SECTION 2

It shall be the duty of the Vice-Commodore to assist the Commodore, and officiate in his absence. The Vice-Commodore shall be the Chairman of the Grounds Committee, which shall consist of himself and the junior elected Trustee. He also shall be Chairman of the Regatta or Homecoming Committee. He shall also be Chairman of the Luau, Fireworks Party (if held), Steak Roast, and any other Regattas
