Entertainment Chairman It shall be his duty to arrange for the entertainment, comfort, and refreshment of the members of the club and their guests. He shall also arrange for the entertainment, food, decoration, and the clean-up at the Luau, Fireworks Party (if held) and Steak Roast and will report to the Vice-Commodore. (August, 2020)

Entertainment Committee: Upon election to office, the Entertainment Chairperson shall nominate up to three members (regular or social) who, along with the Chairman, shall constitute the Entertainment Committee. The Entertainment Chairman shall submit the names of his/her nominees to the officer's board for approval at the January Officers Meeting.
(New Section, Added February 2014)

Fleet Captain: It shall be the duty of the Fleet Captain to arrange the itinerary and course of any cruises made by any flotillas of the Club and be generally in charge of such cruises. For any boat trip that the fleet captain leads by boat to various ports for AYC "poker runs he shall be reimbursed for fuel expenses as listed in Article VII, Section 12.

In the event an elected office has been declared vacant, the Election Committee will be notified and it will become their responsibility to notify all members of said vacancy via club newsletter or general mail. This notification will contain dates for nomination and election, and eligibility requirements. Elections will be held at a general membership meeting following notification. Any person filling a vacated office for a minimum of six (6) months shall be credited with serving a full term.

PROPOSED BYLAW CHANGE ON BORROWING CLUB EQUIPMENT

(THIRD READING – November 2022)

Change to Article XIV, Club Rules, Item #3:

Currently reads:

3. Borrowing Club Equipment. Any use of Club equipment or the Club premises by the members of the Club must be approved by the Officers in their regular meeting. Permission will be given in writing to the member upon request in writing by the member.

Change to read:

3. Borrowing Club Equipment. Club equipment, e.g. tables, chairs, kitchen equipment, must not be removed from the club premises without the prior approval of the Sergeant At Arms. Requests to borrow such equipment should be submitted to the Sergeant At Arms in writing listing the items involved and the date of return. The borrowing member will be financially responsible for any loss or damage to the borrowed items.

Change to Article VI, Section 16:

Currently reads:

Section 16 Sergeant At Arms The Sergeant At Arms shall be responsible for maintaining order at all club general meetings, including, if necessary, the removal of any member who is being disruptive during a meeting, after said member has been appropriately warned beforehand. The Sergeant At Arms shall be responsible for insuring that all members are signed in at membership meetings as well as insuring that only members of good standing and representatives from the Auxiliary and Social membership are present in the meetings.

The Sergeant At Arms shall be responsible for the security of the club, grounds and properties/equipment (this includes any/all loaning/usage of club equipment), including security functions at all club parties. He/she shall be responsible to implement changes to the security of the club as needed, with appropriate approvals as required by either the officer's board or the membership.

Change to read:

Section 16 Sergeant At Arms The Sergeant At Arms shall be responsible for maintaining order at all club general meetings, including, if necessary, the removal of any member who is being disruptive during a meeting, after said member has been appropriately warned beforehand. The Sergeant At Arms shall be responsible for insuring that all members are signed in at membership meetings as well as insuring that only members of good standing and representatives from the Auxiliary and Social membership are present in the meetings.

The Sergeant At Arms shall be responsible for the security of the club, grounds and properties/equipment including security functions at all club parties. He/she shall be responsible to implement changes to the security of the club as needed, with appropriate approvals as required by either the officer's board or the membership.

The Sergeant At Arms shall also be responsible for any/all loaning/usage of club equipment per Article XIV, Item 3, subject to any guidelines/restrictions/fees directed by the Officer Board or membership.

**PROPOSED CHANGE TO BYLAWS REGARDING CLARIFYING
WORK HOURS AND EVENT HOUR SIGNUPS
(THIRD READING - November 2022)**

Article IX, Section 7, Paragraph 1:

Currently Reads:

Work Hours The 12-month period for which work hours shall be tallied shall be from November 1st to October 31st. Each member, except those excused by the Officers and/or the By-Laws, shall be required to work a minimum of twenty (20) hours at the Boat Club and twelve (12) hours of which will be completed by July 10th, six (6) hours to be completed by October 31st. The remaining two hours shall be worked at the DBBC Luau, Fireworks Party (if held) and/or the DBBC Steak Roast. These “work hours” will be in the improvement or maintenance of the Club property (docks, grounds, or buildings) or any work designated by the Officer Board. (August 2020)

Changed to Read:

Work Hours The 12-month period for which work hours shall be tallied shall be from November 1st to October 31st. Each member, except those excused by the Officers and/or the By-Laws, shall be required to work a minimum of twenty (20) hours at the Boat Club. At least twelve (12) hours of which must be completed by July 10th with the remaining hours to be completed by October 31st. A minimum of two (2) hours of these hours shall be known as “party hours” and must be worked at an Officer Board designated event with work signup sheets such as the DBBC Luau, Fireworks Party (if held) and/or the DBBC Steak Roast. If a member fails to show up for their previously signed up work time, the missed work hours will be billed as additional unworked party hours. Other work hours may be worked in the improvement or maintenance of the Club property (docks, grounds, or buildings) or any other work authorized and approved by a club officer.

**PROPOSED CHANGE TO BYLAWS REGARDING HALL/EQUIPMENT
USAGE BY SOCIAL MEMBERS:
(THIRD READING – November 2022)**

Article X, Membership, Section 5, Social Membership, Paragraph G.

Currently reads:

Access / Privileges – Social members will receive a key card, and shall be afforded the same privileges to bar, food, and hall usage as regular members.

Changed to read:

Access / Privileges – Social members will receive a key card, and shall be afforded the same privileges/access to the club bar and food as full members.
Social members may not borrow/use club equipment/hall prior to completing a minimum membership period of one year (12 consecutive months) and be current on all club obligations unless approved in advance by a majority vote of the Officer Board.
