Good luck getting your boats ready for spring! See you at the club! A-A-ron




Ship Store

PROPOSED BY-LAW CHANGES/ADDITIONS

First Reading April 10, 2022

Article IX, Membership Qualifications, Section 4.

Currently reads:

Auxiliary/Widows The organization known as the Detroit Beach Boat Club Auxiliary is dissolved and will cease to exist as of December 31, 2021. Auxiliary members who are widows of past club members as of this date of dissolution may at their discretion become social members of the club at the reduced annual dues rate of \$25 per year and will be exempt from the annual work hour and financial obligations stated in Article X, Section 5. They will also receive I-LYA and AYC reciprocal privileges. (06-09-21)

Change to read:

Auxiliary/Widows The organization known as the Detroit Beach Boat Club Auxiliary is dissolved and will cease to exist as of December 31, 2021. Auxiliary members who are widows of past club members as of this date of dissolution may at their discretion become **full** members of the club at the reduced annual dues rate of \$25 per year and will be exempt from the annual work hour and financial obligations stated in Article X, Section 5. They will also receive I-LYA and AYC reciprocal privileges. (06-09-21)

Article X Membership, Section 6 Family Membership, Paragraph I Membership Transitions:

Add a subparagraph 3 as follows:

3. The seniority date of this Family Membership shall become the seniority date of the Roster member and retain all privileges presently afforded the Roster member.

Article XIII, Dock Rules & Regulations, Section 2, Paragraph B.

Currently reads:

Any member desiring a permanent dock assignment or a \$3.00 a day dock must submit a letter to the Assistant Dock Master, along with his dock initiation fee prior to the February dock bidding of any calendar year. After the April dock bidding, initiation fees and letters will be accepted only for the next boating season or balance of the current boating season if space allows. Dock seniority will start on the day a permanent dock is assigned. In cases of equal seniority, assignments will be made by a lottery system.

Change to read:

Any member desiring a permanent dock assignment or a \$3.00 a day dock must submit a letter to the Assistant Dock Master, along with his dock initiation fee prior to the February dock bidding of any calendar year. After the April dock bidding, initiation fees and letters will be accepted only for the next boating season or balance of the current boating season if space allows. Dock seniority will start on the day a permanent dock is assigned. In cases of equal **dock seniority, assignments will be based upon club membership seniority. If club membership seniority is equal, then assignments will be made by a lottery system.**


