Proposed changes to DBBC Bylaws:

Purpose: To remove the current \$250 financial obligation (First reading June 12, 2024)

Delete from the bylaws the following sections:

Article IX, Section 3, Subsection F, which currently reads:

Each member of this Club shall be responsible for a \$250.00 (December, 2015) financial obligation to be spent for Club services or goods, excepting the payment of dues, special assessments, initiation fees, gasoline, work hours, hall rental fees and associated costs, or other items the membership shall see fit. This obligation may be filled at any time during the year, but all \$250.00 worth must be purchased between previous calendar year November 1st and October 31st of current calendar year or will be billed to the member with the annual dues billing and will be due prior to the issuance of next year's membership card and access to any membership privileges (club access, dockage, etc). Any receipts for Club financial obligation shall be turned in to the appropriate Trustee by the end of the January General Membership Meeting. For billing purposes work hours and financial obligations shall be reported to the Financial Secretary by November 15th by the appropriate Trustee.

Any member designated as retired under the definition of these By-Laws, shall be obligated to a \$100.00 financial obligation instead of the \$250.00 worth of a regular member. All other restrictions remain the same.

New members shall have a financial obligation of \$20.83 per month, prorated on the length of the first year's membership to fulfill their first year's commitment. (December, 2015)

This change takes effect January, 2016.

Article X, Section 5, Subsection I, Subsection 2, which currently reads:

Financial Obligation – Social members shall be responsible for a financial obligation identical to that of regular members, with the same requirements regarding usage, timing, receipts, and billing for unfilled obligations (Refer to Article 9, Section F).

Change the DBBC Bylaws to read as indicated below:

Article X, Section 6, Subsection L, Subsection 2, which currently reads:

The Membership Trustee will calculate pro-rated obligations and work hours for the year in question based on the calendar date of the change year.

Example – If a full member wishes to transition from Full to a Family membership at the beginning of 4th month of the year, that years' work hours would be calculated as $(4/12 * \text{Full Member yearly work hours}) + (8/12 * \text{Family Member yearly work hours})$. An identical calculation would be done to figure obligations expected for that

To read:

The Membership Trustee will calculate pro-rated work hours for the year in question based on the calendar date of the change year.

Example – If a full member wishes to transition from Full to a Family membership at the beginning of 4th month of the year, that years' work hours would be calculated as $(4/12 * \text{Full Member yearly work hours}) + (8/12 * \text{Family Member yearly work hours})$.

Article IX, Section 4, which currently reads:

Auxiliary/Widows The organization known as the Detroit Beach Boat Club Auxiliary is dissolved and will cease to exist as of December 31, 2021. Auxiliary members who are widows of past club members as of this date of dissolution may at their discretion become full members of the club at the reduced annual dues rate of \$25 per year and will be exempt from the annual work hour and financial obligations stated in Article X, Section 5. They will also receive I-LYA and AYC reciprocal privileges. (06-09-21)

Article IX, Section 5, Subsection A3, which currently reads:

They are exempted from financial obligation requirements and from any other minimum expenditure rules that may be established.

To read:

They are exempted from any financial obligation requirements and from any other minimum expenditure rules that may be established.

Article IX, Section 8, Subsection A3, which currently reads:

The first year financial obligation shall be reduced by 50% and will be prorated at 1/12th of this cost as stated in Article IX Section 3 of the By-Laws.

To read:

any first year financial obligation shall be reduced by 50% and will be prorated at 1/12th of this cost.

Article X, Section 6, Subsection A, which currently reads:

Roster Member – This shall be the individual whose name shall appear on all billings, obligations, and work hour reports as shall be developed. This person shall ultimately be responsible for any and all dues, obligations, work hour charges, club seniority, and any special assessments that may be authorized during the time they are a member of the club.

To read:

Roster Member – This shall be the individual whose name shall appear on any billings, obligations, and work hour reports as shall be developed. This person shall ultimately be responsible for any and all dues, obligations, work hour charges, club seniority, and any special assessments that may be authorized during the time they are a member of the club.

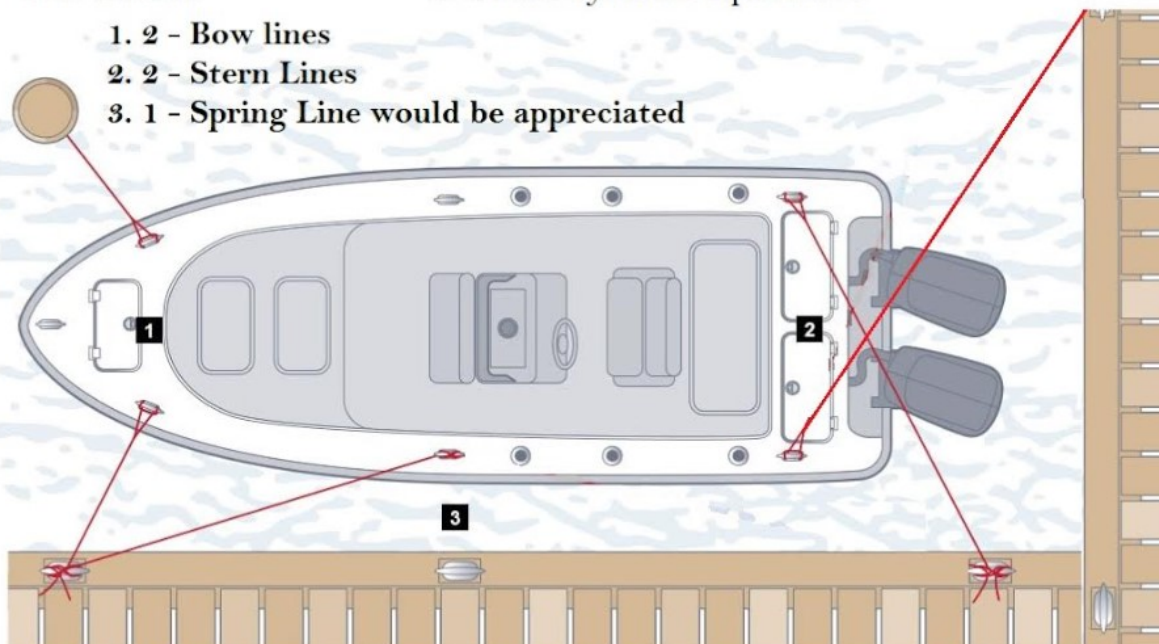
